



Colours

This week we will talk about our favourite things to do: games, toys etc.

We will learn how to introduce ourselves to the new children who are coming, and we will talk about all the things we have already learnt.

We will learn how to collaborate with each other (talk, play all together) and we will learn how to respect the daily rules of the kindergarten.

Our work will focus on the development of speech. With active verbal practice, the children should master the use of language, develop their abilities to communicate. To achieve this goal, we will work on development of all functions of speech, particularly those communication skills that are required in interaction with others. Speech skills like articulation of words, and discrimination of sounds will be practiced. Children need to learn to pronounce words properly and to understand them.

Weekly programme (03.06 - 07.06.2019)

Monday, Jun the 03th

The children introduce themselves in different ways (using voice, movement, imitation, role play)

They tell something about themselves.

Listen to the song about social introduction, and make movements following the rhythm and sing along.

Tuesday, Jun the 04th

The children look at the pictures of different colours and name them.

Revising the song, we learned every previous day and learning new one about colours.

The children present their favourite colours and tell somethings about colours that they can see in their environment.

Wednesday, Jun the 05th

The children will make some objects using Play Doh. The children need to name and describe the object that they modeled.

Later we listen and learn the song about colours and shapes.

Thursday, Jun the 06rd

Introducing my best friend. The children have a task to describe their best friend (eye-colour, hair, etc.)

We talk about favourite games with friends.

The children make a drawing of their best friend.

Friday, Jun the 07th

Revision – of the activities of both the previous and current week.

Note: If the participants show interest for a particular subject it will be developed more thoroughly.
